

Nation pays homage to Mahatma Gandhi on his 72nd death anniversary, martyrs day



- Nation pays homage to the father of the nation Mahatma Gandhi on his 72nd death anniversary. It was on this day in 1948, Mahatma Gandhi fell to the bullet of his assassin. The day is also observed as **Martyrs Day.**
- A Sarva Dharma Prarthana Sabha has been organised at his Samadhi Rajghat in the national capital.
- Vice President M Venkaiah Naidu has paid tributes to the Father of the Nation, Mahatma Gandhi on his death anniversary today. In a series of tweets, Mr Naidu stated, Mahatma Gandhi's life and message of peace and non-violence are relevant for all times and find resonance in every part of the world.
- Through the philosophy of Ahimsa, Satyagraha and Non-Cooperation, Gandhi Ji galvanised masses and spearheaded the national movement.
- In **Madhya Pradesh**, 'Gandhi Stambh' erected at colleges and 'Gandhi Chair' established at universities will be dedicated symbolically on the death anniversary of the Father of Nation Mahatma Gandhi.
- The 'Gandhi Chair' is being set up under the political science department of the universities. While, the Gandhi pillars in colleges are setting up with an objective to help the young generation connect with the Mahatma.

NHRC organise meeting of Statutory Full Commission



- The National Human Rights Commission (NHRC) is organising a meeting of a Statutory Full Commission in New Delhi.
- NHRC Chairperson **Justice HL Dattu** will chair the meeting. The meeting has been called for the discharge of functions towards promotion and protection of human rights as specified in the statutory clauses (b) to (j) of Section 12 of the Protection of Human Rights (PHR) Act.
- The meeting gathers significance as it is being called for the first time since the recent amendment in the PHR Act adding Chairpersons of National Commission for Backward Classes, National Commission for Protection of Child Rights and the Chief Commissioner for Persons with Disabilities as the new deemed Members of the NHRC.
- The Chairpersons for National Commissions for **Minorities**, **Scheduled Castes**, **Scheduled Tribes** and **Women** were already the deemed Members of the Commission.
- The NHRC has been holding the Statutory Full Commission meetings on time to time to explore new areas of cooperation, share best practices and activities of different National Commissions to work towards promotion and protection of human rights in a more cohesive manner.
- The NHRC Members, Members of other Commissions and senior officers will also attend the meeting.

Govt gives nod to amendments in National Commission for Homoeopathy Bill, 2019



- The Union Cabinet has approved the amendments in the **National Commission for Homoeopathy Bill, 2019** for amending the **Homoeopathy Central Council Act, 1973.** Presently, the Bill is pending in Rajya Sabha.
- The amendments will ensure necessary regulatory reforms in the field of Homoeopathy education. This will also enable transparency and accountability for protecting the interest of the general public. The National Commission will promote the availability of affordable healthcare services in all parts of the country.

Govt has released seven billion dollars to all states to tackle climate change: Javadekar



- Environment Minister **Prakash Javadekar** has stated that government has released **seven billion dollars** to all the states for intensive afforestation activities to tackle Climate Change.
- Addressing the **World Sustainable Development Summit 2020** in **New Delhi** in the last four years **India** is the only country in the world which have grown its tree cover by **13 thousand square kilometre**.
- With growing population, people need to focus on sustainable consumption and changing their lifestyle.
- The Minister stated, technology with innovation will be instrumental to tackle **climate change**. He also advocated for more joint research and joint collaboration in this regard.

European Parliament approves Brexit deal with Britain



- **European Parliament** has voted overwhelmingly to approve the Brexit deal with **London**, clearing the final hurdle for Britain's departure from the EU.
- The vote was 621 to 49 in favour of the Brexit deal that British Prime Minister Boris Johnson negotiated with the other 27 EU leaders. After Britain's departure at 11 PM London time the UK will remain within the EU's economic arrangements until the end of the year.
- However, UK will not have any say in policy as it will not be a member of the EU anymore. **Britain** is the first country to leave the EU. UK's official departure will reduce the number of countries in the bloc to 27

- The IRDAI has imposed a penalty of □1 crore each on ICICI Lombard General Insurance and Tata AIG General Insurance company.
- The fine was slapped on ICICI Lombard for selling group personal accident policies and individual personal protect policy beyond the permitted period.
- Tata AIG General Insurance has been penalised for the violation of certain norms related to renewal premium collection.

Tata AIG to offer tailor-made insurance policies for drones



- In a new initiative, private sector general insurer **Tata AIG** has tied up with **Drone Federation of India** for **drone insurance.**
- The Drone Federation of India (DFI) is a not-for-profit industry-led body that strives to build a safe and scalable unmanned aviation industry in India. It had recently organised the Drone Festival of India on January 6 and 7 in New Delhi.
- Tata AIG General Insurance Company was the insurance presenter at the festival and showcased its readiness
 to cater to the insurance and risk management requirements of drone manufacturers, suppliers, buyers, owners and
 operators.

RBI imposes □1 crore penalty on HDFC Bank

- The Reserve Bank of India has imposed a penalty of □1 crore on HDFC Bank for non-compliance of master directions of KYC directions.
- The RBI has imposed a monetary penalty of □1 crore on the bank for failure to undertake on-going due diligence in the case of **39 current accounts** opened for bidding in Initial Public Offer
- Based on the observations made during the on-site Inspection for Supervisory Evaluation of HDFC Bank undertaken
 by the RBI for 2016-17, a scrutiny of 39 current accounts opened by its customers for bidding in IPO was conducted
 by central bank, which revealed, inter alia, that the bank had failed to exercise ongoing due diligence in those
 accounts that, it was observed that the transactions effected in these current accounts were disproportionate to the
 declared income and profile of the customers.
- HDFC Bank was then issued a show cause notice as to why it should not be penalised. After considering the reply received from the bank and oral submissions made in the personal hearing, RBI came to the conclusion that the charge of non-compliance with the direction was sustained and warranted imposition of monetary penalty

RIL approaches NHAI for offering waste plastic-to-road technology



- Mukesh Ambani-led **Reliance Industries** has approached **National Highways Authority of India (NHAI)** for offering its **'waste plastic-to-road'** technology that uses end-of-life plastic for road construction.
- The company has already piloted few projects and has constructed nearly **40 km road** by mixing 50 tonne of end-of-life plastic waste with bitumen at its Nagothane manufacturing site in **Raigad district**.
- It took us some 14-18 months to develop this mechanism where we can use the end-of-life waste plastic-like packaging of snacks and flimsy polyethylene bags, among others, in road construction
- Along with NHAI, RIL is also in talks with state governments and local bodies across the country for offering its technology 1 km of road uses 1 mt of waste plastic and can save nearly **Rs 1 lakh** as it can be utilised as a substitute to bitumen to the extent of 8-10 per cent.
- So, roughly saved Rs 40 lakh. Besides, this plastic also enhances the quality of roads. The roads made using this plastic were completed in two months and sustained the torrential rains of last year without any erosion.
- "NHAI is expected to construct 10,000 km of roads with average four lanes in FY2021, which is around 40,000 km of roads that can use nearly 40,000 mt of waste plastics.

Google announces \$1-million grant to promote news literacy among Indians



- In an effort to counter fake news and misinformation in India, **Google News Initiative (GNI)** has announced a **\$1 million** grant for **Internews**, a news literacy organisation.
- The funding support is part of Google's broader, \$10-million commitment to media literacy.
- According to Google, the grant will work towards building a strong network of senior reporters and journalists, who will counteract fake news in India.
- Google's initiative will focus on delivering news literacy, especially in the **non-metro cities**. Under the programme, Internews will put together a team of 250 journalists, fact-checkers, academicians, and NGO workers, who will be trained by global and Indian experts in a curriculum adapted to local needs and available in seven Indian languages.
- The local leaders will then roll out the training module for new Internet users in non-metro cities in the country, enabling them to better navigate the Internet and assess the information.

Mumbai gets India's first 'walk-through' aviary



- Maharashtra Chief Minister Uddhav Thackeray inaugurated the country's first and biggest 'walk-through' aviary at the Veermata Jijabai Bhosale Udyan and Zoo also known as Byculla Zoo in Mumbai, Maharashtra.
- Spread over 18,200 sq.feet and 44 feet (or a five-storey building) high, the aviary will house over 100 species of rare, exotic and common birds, living their natural environs.
- There is a separate enclosure for aquatic birds, and more birds shall be added on gradually.
- A small bridge also passes through the aviary which will be opened for the public to walk through and view the birds
 at close quarters.
- The VJBUZ also boasts of 17 special enclosures for animals like bears, hyenas, leopards, foxes, Madras Pond Turtles, Barasingha, antelopes, etc., has India's first air-conditioned enclosure for Humboldt Penguins, besides plans to add sections for the Asiatic Lion, tigers and another bird enclosure.

- Thackeray also laid the foundation stone for **a new flyover connecting Saat Rasta to Haji Ali** which will drastically cut down the travel time.
- The Chief Minister also laid the foundation for another flyover linking Saat Rasta with Dr. E. Moses Road, Mahalaxmi, passing via the famous Dhobighat, to decongest traffic on Mahalaxmi Bridge and towards Worli naka.
- Thackeray launched the first of the 64 forestation projects by the 'Miyawaki' method, at Bhakti Park in Wadala on Sunday, on a 2.50 acres plot.
- The 'Miyawaki' method implying maximum trees in minimum area to increase bio-diversity and the city's green cover which will be implemented at 64 locations with 40 types of local or other trees to create lush green forests amid the city's concrete jungle.

Interceptor boat C-448 commissioned at New Mangalore



- The Karnataka government will provide 160 acres of land at Kenjar village in Mangaluru taluk to set up a Coast Guard Training Academy.
- The commissioning of **C-448** (a high-speed interceptor boat) of Indian Coast Guard at New Mangalore.
- Karnataka Industrial Areas Development Board (KIADB) has allotted the land for setting up a Coast Guard Training Academy.
- The C-448 is fitted with the latest navigation and communication equipment designed for high-speed interception, close coast patrol, low-intensity maritime operations, search and rescue, and maritime surveillance. This interceptor boat is capable of operating in shallow waters and deep seas.
- On joining the Indian Coast Guard fleet at New Mangalore, the ship will be deployed for patrolling, rescue operations and other duties.
- This interceptor boat built by **L&T** (Larsen & Toubro) shipyard

S Jaishankar lays foundation stone of Sardar Vallabhbhai Patel Centre at Kevadia in Gujarat



- External Affairs Minister S Jaishankar laid the foundation stone of the **Sardar Vallabhbhai Patel** Centre for Empowerment and Livelihoods near **the Statue of Unity** at **Kevadia** in **Gujarat.**
- This will be a state-of-the-art skill Development centre in this tribal area. This Residential Centre will have all modern infrastructure including accommodation for about 100 youth at a time. It will run several free of charge skill courses aligned to the **National Skills Qualification Framework (NSQF).**
- To begin with, the majority of the courses will focus to meet the demand of tourism and hospitality requirements at Kevadia. These include Food and Beverage Steward, Room Attendant, Mechanized housekeeping, agroprocessing specially the dragon-fruit processing, soap making for individuals and women's self-help groups.

RBI appoints Executive Director Janak Raj as member of MPC



- The Reserve Bank of India (RBI) appointed its Executive Director **Janak Raj** as member of the **Monetary Policy Committee (MPC)**, the highest interest rate setting body.
- The Monetary Policy Committee takes decisions based on majority vote. Each member has one vote but the RBI Governor get a casting vote in case of a tie
- Raj replaces **MD.Patra**, who was recently elevated as Deputy Governor of the RBI. The decision to appoint Janak Raj was taken at the 581st meeting of the central board held in Mumbai. The MPC is headed by the RBI Governor.

China Ranked World's Second Largest Arms Producer Trailing Behind US



- The opaque Chinese arms industry has made the Asian nation the **world's second largest producer** of munitions, a clear shift from a decade ago
- The report by the Stockholm International Peace Research Institute (SIPRI) suggests that China's weapons production, which has previously been shrouded in mystery owing to a lack of transparency, has grown as three of the world's top 10 arms companies are Chinese.

- China is the second largest arms producer in the world, behind the US and ahead of Russia.
- This still represents a dramatic shift over the last 10 years as China in the past was a big importer of weapons from Russia and Ukraine.

Assam tops in budgetary practices, followed by Odisha, Andhra: Survey



- **Assam** has emerged as the top state in terms of best practices followed in **budget formulation**, followed by **Odisha** and **Andhra Pradesh**, says a survey by Transparency International.
- The survey was based on four parameters -- public disclosure, budgetary process, post budget fiscal management and efforts to make budget more transparent and citizen friendly.
- The states which figured lower in the ranking were Goa, Maharashtra and Punjab.
- It is ironical that being a 'Union of States', state budgets in India have never received such importance as claimed by Union Budget.

CURRENT AFFAIRS: SCIENCE AND TECHNOLOGY 10 more wetlands in India declared as Ramsar sites



- India has added 10 more wetlands to sites protected by the Ramsar Convention, Union Environment Minister Prakash Javadekar announced
- The 10 new ones are Nandur Madhameshwar, a first for Maharashtra; **Keshopur-Miani**, **Beas Conservation Reserve** and **Nangal in Punjab**; and **Nawabganj**, **Parvati Agra**, **Saman**, **Samaspur**, **Sandi** and **Sarsai Nawar in Uttar Pradesh**. The other Ramsar sites are in Rajasthan, Kerala, Odisha, Madhya Pradesh, Himachal Pradesh, Assam, West Bengal, Jammu and Kashmir, Andhra Pradesh, Manipur, Gujarat, Tamil Nadu and Tripura.
- With this, a total of 37 sites in the country have been recognised under the international treaty. Wetlands declared as Ramsar sites are protected under strict guidelines.

• The Convention, signed in 1971 in the Iranian city of **Ramsar**, is one of the oldest inter-governmental accord for preserving the ecological character of wetlands. Also known as the Convention on Wetlands, it aims to develop a global network of wetlands for conservation of biological diversity and for sustaining human life.

New mission to take first peek at Sun's poles: NASA

- NASA, in collaboration with the **European Space Agency (ESA)**, is launching a new spacecraft next month to snap the first pictures of the **Sun's north** and **south poles**,
- The **Solar Orbiter spacecraft** will have its first opportunity to launch from **Cape Canaveral** in the U.S. on February 7, 2020.
- The spacecraft will use Venus's and the Earth's gravity to swing itself out of the ecliptic plane the swath of space, roughly aligned with the Sun's equator, where all planets orbit.
- The Sun plays a central role in shaping space around us. Its massive magnetic field stretches far beyond Pluto, paving a superhighway for charged solar particles known as the solar wind.
- When bursts of solar wind hit Earth, they can spark space weather storms that interfere with our GPS and communications satellites at their worst, they can even threaten astronauts
- To prepare for arriving solar storms, scientists monitor the Sun's magnetic field.

Motera Cricket Stadium, world's largest, could host IPL 2020 final in Ahmedabad



- The final of the Indian Premier League (IPL) 2020 can be played at the Sardar Patel Stadium (Motera) Stadium in Ahemadabad, Gujarath.
- The Motera Stadium will become the largest cricket arena in the world when its construction is completed. The spectacular stadium will have a seating capacity of 1,10,000 spectators overtaking the Melbourne Cricket Ground (MCG) in Australia which is the largest cricket stadium in the world at the moment.
- The BCCI had earlier planned to host a game between Asia XI and the World XI at the Motera Stadium but the plan was dropped as the construction work for the completion of the stadium will not finish in March this year.
