

National Mathematics Day 2020: Observed on December 22



- National Mathematics Day is celebrated every year on December 22 across the nation to recognise and celebrate the works of Srinivasa Ramanujan.
- The former Prime Minister **Manmohan Singh**, on **February 26**, **2012**, declared December 22 as the National Mathematics Day to mark the mathematician's birth anniversary.
- 2020 ensures 133rd birth anniversary of Ramanujan.

Achievements :

- In 1916 he was awarded the Bachelor of Science degree.
- In 1917 he was elected to the London Mathematical Society.
- In 1918 he was elected a Fellow of the Royal Society for his research on Elliptic Functions and theory of numbers.
- The same year in October he became the first Indian to be elected a Fellow of Trinity College, Cambridge.

New electricity rules give consumers across India the right to 24x7 supply



• Government Notifies **New Electricity Rights of Consumers Rules**, **2020** to give consumers the right to **24**×7 **supply**.



- Minister of State (Independent Charge) for Power and New and Renewable Energy **R K Singh on 21 December 2020** stated, Power distribution companies (discoms) across the country are monopolies whether government or private and the consumer has no alternative.
- These rules provide for **rights of consumers and obligations of distribution licensees**, release of new connection and modification in existing connection, metering arrangement, billing and payment.
- The distribution licensee shall supply 24x7 power to all consumers. However, the commission may specify lower hours of supply for some categories of consumers like agriculture.
- According to Union Power Secretary Sanjiv N Sahai, this relaxation has been allowed since pumps do need to be run 24x7 for supplying water to fields.

Union environment Minister releases Status of Leopards in India 2018 report



- The Union environment minister Shri Prakash Javadekar released a report of the Status of Leopard in India 2018.
- The population of leopards in India has **increased by 60 percent**, according to a report released by the government.
- As per report,India now has **12,852 leopards**.
- More than 60 per cent increase in population has been recorded over the previous estimate which was conducted in 2014.
- To the States of **Madhya Pradesh (3,421), Karnataka(1783)** and Maharashtra(1690) who have recorded the **highest leopard** estimates.

About Leopards :

- Leopards are among the most adaptable carnivores, and are known to exist very close to human habitations.
- This year had found four distinct sub-populations of leopards in India with high genetic variations leopards of the Western Ghats, the Deccan Plateau semi-arid region, the Shivalik mountains, and the Terai region in North India.

- On Dec 19 to 20, 2020, The 8th North East Festival (NEF) was held at Radisson Blu Hotel in Guwahati, Assam.
- This is the **first time** that Guwahati hosted this annual two day event.
- Due to COVID-19, this year the festival will be organized with minimum human presence and broadcasted on all over the globe through digital platforms.
- The Inaugural Session on Development Agenda for North East will be about highlighting the positive works done by the various Chief Ministers of the region in the presence of Union DoNER Minister, Dr. Jitendra Singh.
- This festival mainly focuses on the Growth Agenda for North East Post COVID-19.

UP launches P2P trading platform for rooftop solar power in Lucknow



- Uttar Pradesh has become the first in India and South Asia to launch the block chain-enabled peer to peer (P2P) trading platform for rooftop solar power producers.
- The **Uttar Pradesh Power Corporation Limited (UPPCL)** and **Uttar Pradesh New and Renewable Energy Development Agency (UPNEDA)** are hosting the first-of-its-kind pilot project involving energy generated from solar rooftop systems installed on buildings in Lucknow.
- The Project is being implemented by Indian Smart Grid Forum (ISGF)
- This pilot project will demonstrate the feasibility of rooftop solar energy trading through smart contracts on the blockchain platform between prosumers with their neighbouring households.

India's first hypersonic wind tunnel test facility inaugurated in Hyderabad



- Defence Minister **Rajnath Singh** inaugurated the advanced **Hypersonic Wind Tunnel (HWT)** test facility in **Hyderabad**.
- HWT Test facility is pressure vacuum driven enclosed free jet facility having nozzle exit diameter of 1 metre.
- That will simulate Mach No 5 to 12 (Mach represents the multiplication factor to the speed of sound).
- After America and Russia, **India is the third country** to have such a large facility.
- In that test Defence Minister also visited two anti-drone technologies which were demonstrated by DRDO labs on the occasion.

Origin of 4 new games :

- Gatka originates from Punjab. It is a traditional fighting style of the Nihang Sikh Warriors, used both as self-defense as well as a sport.
- Thang-Ta is a Manipur marital art.

- Indian boxers bagged nine medals including three golds, two silver and four bronze at the Cologne Boxing World Cup held in Koln, Germany.
- The Cologne Boxing World 2020 was hosted by the European Boxing Confederation (EUBC).
