- Making sure drivers are always in full or required PPE while on sites.
- Making sure that all drivers full time follow health codes, warning signs, and PPE properly (internally and externally)
- Assist in driver recruitments in coordinating with HR and Operations
- Coordinating with HR on drivers' permission and issuing security gate passes and maintaining gate pass register
- Inspect and advice truck repairs and maintenance to avoid breakdowns on the road.
- Any other duties assigned by the management
